



VOLUNTEER BASIC REQUIREMENTS

Volunteers must:

- be 18 years and older.
- commit to a weekly shift for a minimum period of six months.
- complete an application form, online interview, training and orientation and attend a hands on sessions before beginning their volunteer duties.

We have a limited number of available openings, and applicants must meet the volunteer requirements to be considered for an interview. Would you like to improve the quality of life for cats that are waiting to be adopted at the Humane Society of Durham Region? We are now accepting applications for Feline Enrichment Volunteers.

As a Feline Enrichment Volunteer you will help to socialize the cats to help them find their forever homes and spend time grooming, petting, playing, sitting and talking with the cats.

Volunteers must:

- Be over 18 years of age
- Previous experience interacting with cats
- Be able to work alone with minimum supervision once trained
- Commit to a weekly shift for a minimum of six months

7 days a week from 11am to 6pm
