In addition, you will help our Veterinarian with horse visits under her mobile license. This will include setting up the x-ray machine, ultrasound, dental equipment and other instruments and materials required for different procedures as well as inputting notes into the computer. This exciting opportunity will allow you to observe a variety of procedures such as equine dentals, ultrasounds for breeding purposes, intra-articular injections, lameness exams and others.
